### **TUITION FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR**

Tuition for the 2021-2022 school year is:                         \$375 for students in K-2<sup>nd</sup>  
  \$525 for students in 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>

Classes are held:   Sundays 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. for all students  
  Wednesdays 5 p.m.-6:30 p.m. for 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>  
(Wednesdays are optional for Temple Shir Shalom students.)

In order to enroll in MAGAL, a membership in Temple Israel, Temple Shir Shalom, or Congregation Beth Am is required. Bar/Bat Mitzvah candidates must be enrolled in MAGAL.

### **Tuition Payment Options (please select one):**

Option #1 (preferred) – Pay in full by August 1<sup>st</sup>

Option #2 (half) – Pay  $\frac{1}{2}$  by August 1<sup>st</sup> and  $\frac{1}{2}$  by December 1<sup>st</sup>  
                                  Two payments of \$262.50 for 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> OR  
                                  Two payments of \$187.50 for K-2<sup>nd</sup>

Option #3 (8 monthly payments) – A deposit of \$125 per child is due by August 1<sup>st</sup>. Monthly payments are due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. The first payment is due on September 15<sup>th</sup> and the last payment is due on April 15<sup>th</sup>.

## Tuition Payment Instructions

### Temple Israel:

#### *When paying by check*

- Make checks payable to MAGAL and mail to:

- In the “Memo” section, list the student’s name and that the check is for MAGAL Tuition.
- MAGAL payments and all other payments to TI must be made separately. For example, if paying TI dues and MAGAL Tuition, you need to write 2 separate checks.
- Checks brought in person are to be placed in the Red Box in the TI Office.

*When paying by credit card over the phone, state the payment is for MAGAL and give the student’s name.*

#### *When paying by credit card on the TI website*

- Click “**Donate**” and choose “**Dues and Fees**” from the dropdown. Type the student name and reason for payment in the box labeled “The Meitin Alliance for Growth And Learning (MAGAL) Hebrew School Tuition & Fees.”

### Temple Shir Shalom:
